



STNA Social Media Policy

Introduction

The Southern Tasmanian Netball Association has a zero tolerance to negative outbursts, poor behaviour and negative comments using any social media pages that reflect poorly on the Association and its members.

STNA Policy

- If a player uses social media pages to air their grievances in any matter involving the Association, disciplinary action may be taken by the STNA Netball Management Committee.
- If any player is recognised on any social media page wearing any recognisable part of an Association or affiliated Club uniform and thus bringing the Association into disrepute, that player may face disciplinary action by the STNA Netball Management Committee.
- If any player is openly abusive; participates in acts of discrimination; harassment and/or bullying on social media the person involved may risk expulsion from the Association.
- Any member of the Association and their families who portray the Association in a negative and derogative way using any social media may face disciplinary action from the Netball Management Committee

All disciplinary actions will be determined by the STNA Netball Management Committee based on the severity of the behaviour. This may result in a fine, suspension from participating in a game/s or a family member not being admitted to the Centre, or other appropriate action.
