



STNA Smoking & Alcohol Policy

Introduction

This policy is intended to inform visitors to the Southern Tasmanian Netball Association (STNA) Creek Road Netball Centre facilities about expectations regarding cigarette smoking and alcohol consumption.

The STNA recognises that passive smoking is hazardous to health and those non-smoking members and visitors have the right to be protected from exposure to tobacco smoke.

Additionally, the STNA recognises the importance in holding a liquor license in the value it adds to the association, enabling it to generate income and hold social functions, but in doing so the STNA also accepts the responsibilities and expectations of the community in strictly adhering to the liquor licensing laws.

Accordingly, the following policy shall apply to all functions, meetings and activities undertaken at the STNA and will apply to all members, officials, players and visitors.

STNA Policy

Smoking: The entire Creek Road Netball Centre including both stadiums are smoke free areas. There is no smoking permitted within 20 metres of any entry point to the venue including car parks.

Alcohol: Alcohol will be served according to the legal and moral requirements of the STNA's Liquor License with the safety and wellbeing of patrons the priority. This will include:

- the STNA will maintain a current appropriate Liquor License
- RSA trained staff on shift during bar service
- when serving non pre-packaged alcohol standard drink measures will be served at all times
- information posters about Standard Drink measures will be displayed in the bar
- the Liquor License and all legal signage will be displayed at the bar

STNA does not encourage excessive or rapid consumption of alcohol and alcohol will not be served to any person who is intoxicated or drunk. Servers will follow RSA training procedures when refusing service and drunken patrons will be asked to leave the premises.

Alcohol will not be served to persons aged under 18 years and servers will ask for proof of age whenever necessary or whenever in doubt. Only photo ID's will be accepted.

Implementation

All STNA members will take responsibility for this smoking and alcohol policy and any non-compliance will be handled according to the following process:

- explanation of the STNA policy to the person/people concerned
- Continued non-compliance with the policy should be handled by at least two board/committee members (or servers in the instance of alcohol) who will use their
