



Spring Junior's Rules

Matches

1. All players will need to register on PlayHQ to their team. A link and instructions will be sent to your team contact after the team entry is completed. Options for registration include 12 months or 3 months. The 12-month option should be selected by anyone who will be playing both rosters and/or will be playing in other rosters at STNA or some other associations (State League, Sorell roster, Kingston rosters). Those choosing to play just one roster or are unsure if they will continue playing should select the 3-month option.
2. Drawn finals will be resolved by a 2-goal advantage after swapping ends at full time.

Player Eligibility

1. All players must register to their team in PlayHQ.
2. All players registered in PlayHQ from the previous Winter Roster Season will not be charged an additional fee to register to this roster, unless their current Netball Tas registration expires during the season.
3. If a player is not currently registered in a previous roster, they may purchase a 3-month PlayHQ registration period.
4. Boys may play in eligible grades. Please refer to STNA's Conduct of Roster (1.5 and 1.6) to see these eligible grades.
5. Players may move between grades as 'fill ins' if the movement aligns with the STNA Conduct of Roster's policies on movement of players (refer 4). If a team wishes to play a fill in who do not meet the policies, approval must be granted by the STNA Office.
6. Players may fill in for 4 games above their grade. On the 5th game, players will be re-deemed into the higher age group/division.
7. Players must play a minimum of 3 games to be eligible for finals. If a team wishes to play someone who has not met the 3-game minimum, approval needs to be granted by the STNA Office prior to the final.
8. Fill-in players may participate in up to 3 games before registration is required for any further play."

Dress Code

1. All players in a team must wear matching colours (tops and bottoms). Skirts, shorts or tights can be worn.
2. We have spare/clash bibs at the office if required.
3. The roster follows the official Rules of Netball – that is, all jewellery must be removed (not taped) and nails must be short (even if gloves are worn). Umpires have to right to refuse players from taking the court if they breach this rule.
4. Surgically implanted piercings must be approved by the STNA office before the player takes the court.

Behaviour

1. Teams, individual players, coaches and umpires will be expected to behave in a sporting manner.



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2. They will respect their opponents and show appreciation for good play on both sides.
